I want to donate clothes: Accepting clothes and shoes, drop off Tuesday-Thursday from 9:00am-3:00pm and Friday from 9:00am-12:00pm. Call ahead before dropping off, do not just leave donations outside the church.

Center for Women's Wisdom:

I need clothes: Clothing giveaway on last Thursday of each month 11-1, women's or unisex clothes only. Homeless women can request clothes during the month.

I need clothes: In winter by appointment. Beginning in April donations distributed on Wednesdays 10AM-Noon. Seasonal clothes, children's clothes, and winter outerwear are available.

I want to donate clothes: Call ahead to set up an appointment before dropping off donations, doesn't have to be on Wednesday. Accepting seasonal clothes, children's clothes, winter outerwear (beginning to accept spring)

I need clothes: Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 10am-11:45am and 12:30pm-2:45pm at the giveaway room, picture ID required, all types of clothes available

I want to donate clothes: Donations can be dropped off every day of the week from 8:30-6:30, call before so someone can grab the donations, do not just leave them outside. All types of clothes are accepted.

Loaves & Fishes Hidden Treasures Thrift Store:

When they are full no donations are accepted, check their Facebook page before dropping off donations.
